UA researchers' primary topic areas include:

- Research on the emotional effects of the tornadoes on children's behavior
- Extreme event engineering research, including engineering reconnaissance research for Hurricane Katrina, the Tuscaloosa and Joplin tornados and recently the Moore, Oklahoma tornado.
- · Post traumatic stress treatment research for severe storm PTSD, using virtual reality technology.
